Thank you for considering the Edmonton Police Service as a place to volunteer your time, energy and skills. The Edmonton Police Service is proud to involve the citizens of Edmonton in many of its programs as part of its commitment to community policing. If you are accepted into the volunteer programs of the EPS, you will join over 500 other dedicated individuals serving their community and the police members in a variety of roles.

Because of the nature of police work, it is important that persons associated with a police service be of good ethical character. Therefore a thorough reference and criminal background will be conducted on all candidates. To proceed with the initial screening and application, you will be required to provide two written letters of reference and the contact information of three additional individuals who would be willing to respond to a reference check.

All volunteers of the EPS will have significant contact with the public. As such, all volunteers are required to have excellent written and verbal communication skills and are expected to present themselves professionally in dress, conduct and appearance. In addition, volunteers are to be representative of their community and it is requested they apply to an EPS volunteer program nearest to where they live or work.

Attached is an application package for volunteer involvement with the Edmonton Police Service. This package is to be completed and submitted only if you are expressing an interest in a current posting for a volunteer requirement within the Service, and you believe that you meet the requirements outlined on the posting. Before proceeding with an application, please review the following minimal requirements for volunteering within the EPS:

- be of 18 years of age and older;
- have Canadian citizenship or landed immigrant status;
- be a resident of Edmonton or of a surrounding community for a minimum of one year;
- have no criminal convictions for which a pardon or records suspension has not been granted;
- have no associations with those who are known to have extensive criminal records;
- be willing to give a one-year commitment;
- volunteer regularly as required by the program applying for;
- attend all required training sessions; and
- be able to write and communicate clearly and fluently in English.

Once you have completed the Volunteer Application / Pre-Screening Form, it can be dropped off at your local divisional or community Police Station. Your application may take a month to be processed as it is dependent upon the availability of our Police Members to follow it up. Once your application has been processed, you will be invited to an interview and will be required to fill out a detailed Enhanced Security Clearance that will include you, your immediate family members and anyone who resides with you over the age of twelve (12).
