## 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Crime Prevention Awards 2012

Alberta Solicitor General and Public Security seeks to acknowledge the efforts of individuals, youths, organizations, businesses, community groups, media and police members who make an extraordinary contribution in promoting community safety through crime prevention.

### Selection Criteria

Nominations will be reviewed and assessed on sustainable and effective crime prevention elements:

- **Demonstrates commitment to issues of local concern:** the nominee engages in dialogue with community members to share concerns and ideas;
- **Uses a logical planning and implementation process:** the nominee identifies needs, develops a plan, implements the plan and evaluates the outcome of the actions taken;
- **Invests in capacity:** the nominee takes steps to develop capacity (knowledge and resources) to successfully implement crime prevention activities;
- **Exhibits leadership:** the nominee is committed and trusts others to share in the work;
- **Creates partnerships:** i.e. the nominee works in partnership with community members by communicating, cooperating, coordinating, and collaborating for effective outcomes;
- **Actualizes outcomes:** the nominee sets realistic goals and objectives related to implementing a tangible initiative which enhances community awareness and reduces crime.

**Nomination Deadline: Noon, February 10, 2012**
