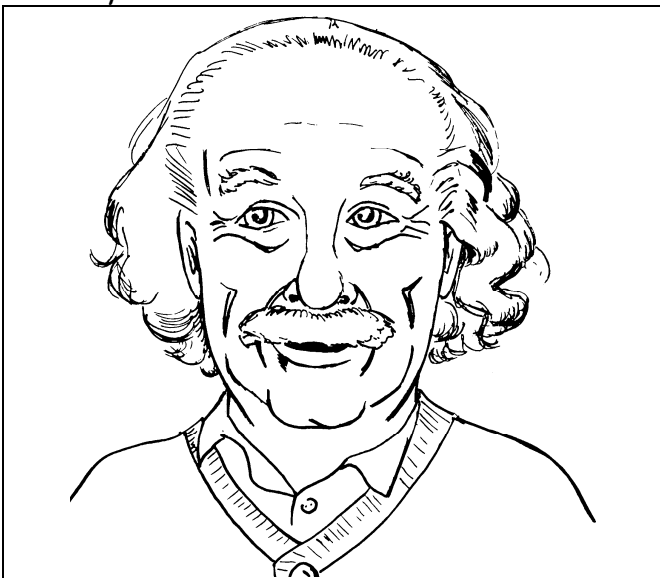
What makes you different also makes you special. These people took their problems and turned them into gifts.

Bear Facts on Bullies



No one has the right to hurt you or make you feel bad about yourself. If you're being bullied or know someone who is, you can...

1
Ignore the bully.
Most bullies will go away if you don't pay attention to them.


2
Tell the bully to stop bothering you.

3
Tell an adult, like your parents or teacher.
An adult can stop the bullying.

4
If you see someone else being bullied, help them or get an adult.

Respect Check

Respect isn't free. You pay for it by respecting others. See how you do in this respect game. When you land on a square, flip a coin to "answer" the question. Heads is yes, tails is no. Use a button, coin or piece of paper to be your marker as you move along the squares to the finish. If there's no



You see someone who's never hurt you, you just don't like the person. Do you yell names at that person?
Yes - back 5 spaces!
No - You don't have to like that person. Nobody is liked by everybody. Which means someone out there doesn't like you. Would you like that person yelling names at you? Move ahead 5 spaces.

Your teacher has asked you to be quiet in the classroom. Do you get mad? (Flip the coin) Yes (heads)- back 3 spaces! The teacher is the boss in the classroom. Home rules or your rules don't apply here.
No (tails) - good for you! You're showing respect to your teacher. Move ahead 3 spaces

Start

You're throwing snowballs at someone's car. A woman opens the door to the nearest house and starts yelling at you to stop. Do you yell back?

Yes - *What?* How can you claim to respect a person when you don't respect their property? Back 4 spaces! (Maybe you'd like your TV put out in the snow?)

No - You stop throwing the snowballs. Ahead 4 spaces!

Finish

You're walking to the store. You pass some police officers standing in the parking lot and for *no reason at all* one of them tells you to turn around and go home! Do you listen to him?

Yes - Of course, there's a reason, he just doesn't have to give it to you. Police (and firefighters and paramedics) are here to protect our community. That deserves your respect. You win! Move ahead 4 spaces.

No - You walked straight into an unsafe situation! Move back to start!

Everybody wants to be respected. That means being considerate of the person, their property, their space and their things. If you're not sure how to be respectful, just think how you would like to be treated and do that.

Being respectful doesn't make you weak or not as good as the person you respect. It just means you know how to treat people. And that makes you look good.

Don't forget to respect yourself too. If you wouldn't call a classmate stupid, don't call yourself stupid either. We all make mistakes. And don't be afraid to ask someone to stop (nicely) if that person isn't respecting you or your property.

Internet Safety

never give out any personal information - including your name, address, phone number or where you go to school.

never send anyone your picture over the internet without first asking your parents if it's okay.



always tell your parents if someone you "meet" online asks for information about you.

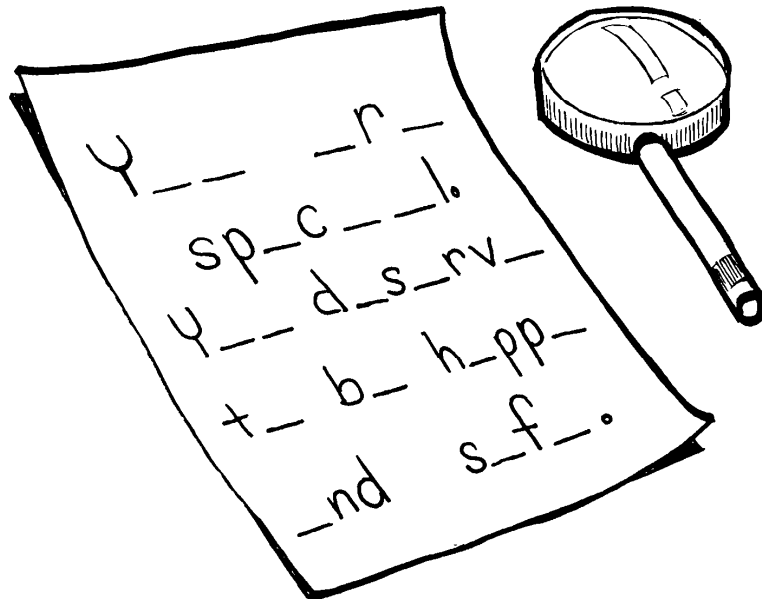
Stranger danger! Never agree to get together with anyone you "meet" online. It could be dangerous.

Barney and Zack were flying a kite in the park when their best friend, Jane, ran up. She was crying.

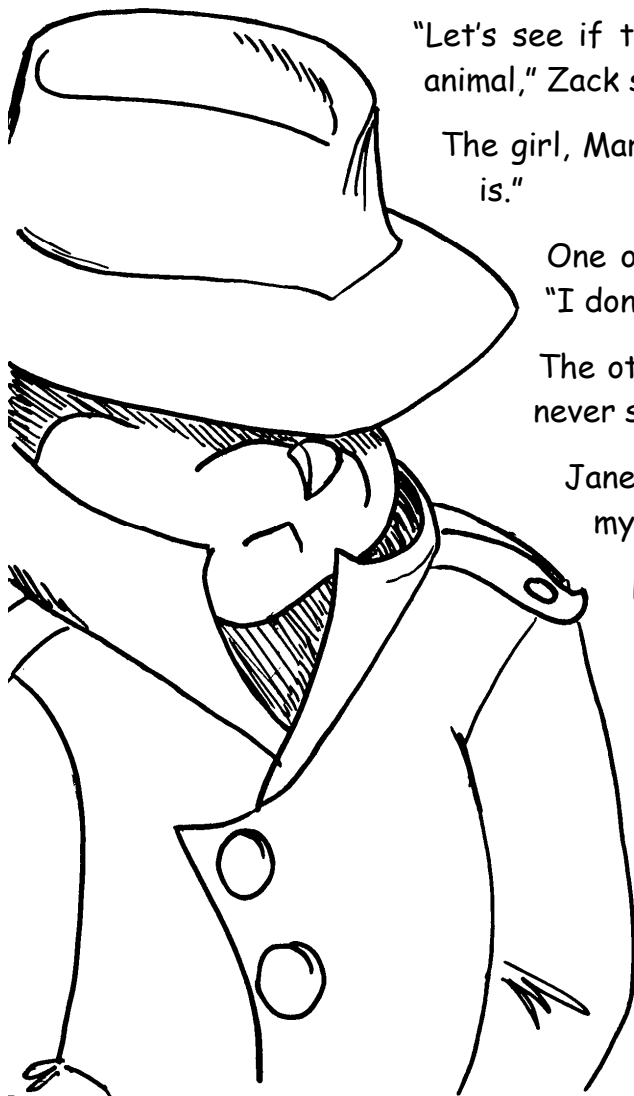
"What's wrong?" Zack asked.

Jane sat down with a big sigh. "I'll never get my stuffie back!" she said.

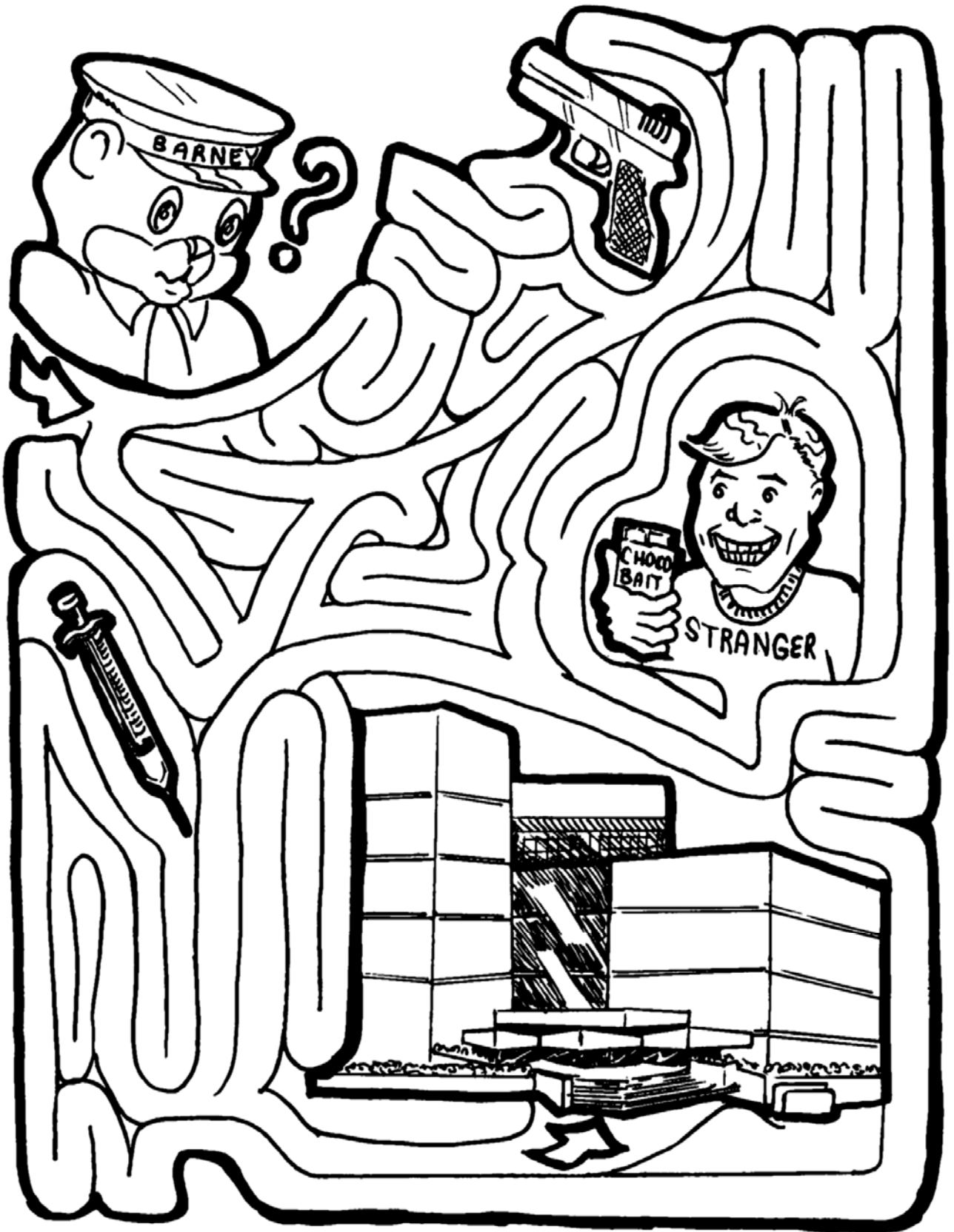
Barney tapped Zack on the shoulder. "Hold on," Zack said, "I think Barney knows who took it!"

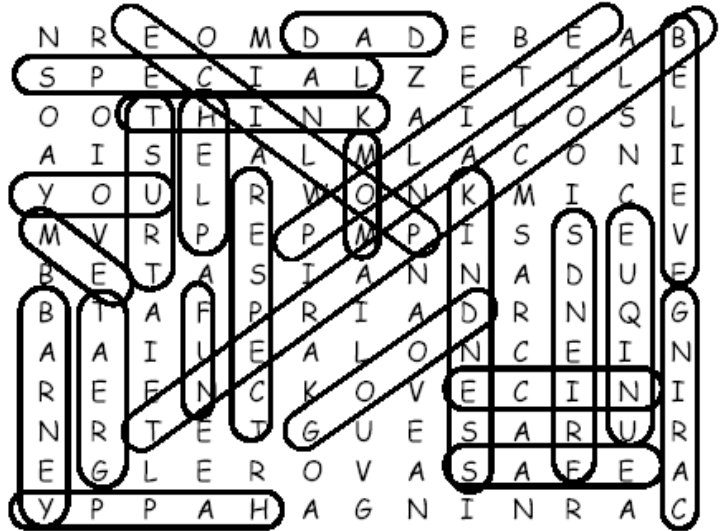

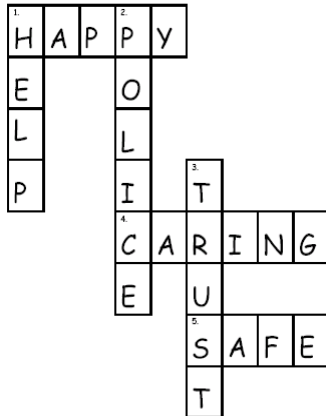
