Thank you for considering this opportunity with the Edmonton Police Service Cadet Corps. The Edmonton Police Service (EPS) is proud to involve young citizens of Edmonton in many of its programs as part of its commitment to community policing.

The Edmonton Police Cadet Corps. gives a unique opportunity for youth ages 16 – 18 years of age to learn about a future career in law enforcement with the EPS. The program is facilitated from September to May. As a representative of EPS, a Cadet will have significant contact with the public and police members. As such, the Cadet is expected to present themselves professionally in dress, conduct and appearance. It is important that persons associated with a police service be of good moral character. A thorough reference and enhanced security clearance will be conducted on all candidates. To proceed with the initial screening and application, you will be required to provide two written letters of reference and contact information for a reference who would be willing to respond to a reference check (Personal / Professional).

Attached is an application package for the Edmonton Police Cadets Corps. This package is to be completed and submitted only if you can meet the requirements outlined below. Before proceeding with an application, please review the following minimum requirements:

In order to be eligible for the program, youth must:

- Be of 16 18 years of age; 16 years of age at date of program start; no older than 18 years of age on application submission date
- Have completed an application assignment (current resume and cover letter)
- Have 2 written letters of reference (professional, volunteer or academic reference no family or friends references)
- Be attending school full time with good grades
- Have a recent report card from school
- Be able to maintain at least a 75% attendance record with the program
- Have Canadian citizenship or Permanent Resident status
- Be a resident of Edmonton or a surrounding area
- Have no criminal convictions for which a pardon has not been granted
- Have no associations with those who are known to have extensive criminal records
- Be able to write and communicate clearly and fluently in English

Once you have completed the application package, it must be emailed to Leeanne HARVEY at <u>cadets@edmontonpolice.ca</u>.

Your application will then be processed and screened. At this time we will be looking to see if all of the requirements are met to process your application. After the pre-screening process, you may be invited to a Fitness Test and BDI interview. You would then be required to fill out a detailed and enhanced security clearance that will include yourself, your immediate family members and anyone who resides with you over the age of twelve (12).

Fitness testing will take place Wednesday, May 30, 2018 at Griesbach Training Centre, 14310-109 Street NW. Once this pre-testing is done, you will receive a phone call to participate in our interview process. Cadet classes start October 3, 2018.
