Car Curfew is a free and voluntary program. By placing this sticker on your vehicle's rear window (lower driver's side), your vehicle may be stopped by police to verify that it is not stolen if driven between 1 a.m. and 5 a.m.

DID YOU KNOW...

- Most vehicles are stolen between 1:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m.
- About 3,500 vehicles are reported stolen in Edmonton each year.
- Many stolen vehicles are used in other crimes.
- Stolen vehicles may be dismantled and have their parts sold.

YOU CAN PREVENT VEHICLE THEFT

- Do not leave your vehicle running with the key in the ignition.
- Never leave spare keys hidden in the vehicle.
- Lock up your vehicle and close your windows.
- Use a steering wheel lock device.
- Park in a well-lit area.
